

CITIZENS' CURRICULUM ADVISORY COMMITTEE OPPORTUNITY

Opportunities are available for community members who want to learn about curriculum options and contribute to the success of teaching and learning in the Hillsboro School District.

The Citizens' Curriculum Advisory Committee (CCAC) serves as a resource to the Board and Superintendent in setting the direction for long-range curriculum development and assisting in the development of the schools' curriculum and instructional programs. Committee responsibilities include reviewing curriculum, instructional programs, proposed new courses, and study team recommendations, and reporting findings and recommendations to the Board of Directors for discussion and action.

Committee members are appointed by the Board of Directors to two-year terms. Candidates must reside within the boundaries of the Hillsboro School District and be available to attend committee meetings, which are conducted on the first Monday evening of each month, October through June. Committee members are also invited to participate in sub-committees and special projects, as opportunities arise.
