Intel Volunteers Beautify Six Hillsboro Schools in Large Single-Day Effort

More than 425 employees from the Product Development Group to assist schools through project completion and Intel's volunteer matching grants

July 18, 2016, Hillsboro, OR – Six Hillsboro schools: Rosedale, Ladd Acres and Patterson Elementary Schools; Brown Middle School; and Glencoe and Hillsboro High Schools, will benefit from the Intel Product Development Group's (PDG) Global Day of Service on Wednesday, July 20, when more than 425 volunteers from the group will complete a variety of projects on their campuses.

Intel has a long history of service and partnership with the Hillsboro School District. Through its volunteer matching grant program, in which non-profit organizations are eligible to receive \$10 per hour of Intel employee volunteer time provided a 20-hour threshold is met, the company has donated millions of dollars to Hillsboro schools. In 2015, Intel employees and retirees volunteer nearly 20,000 hours at Hillsboro schools, clubs, and athletic programs, which resulted in \$194,000 in matching grants.

On Wednesday, July 20, 2016, volunteers will spend seven hours (8 a.m. to 3 p.m. with lunch from 11:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.) at the schools sites completing the following projects:

- Glencoe High School—126 volunteers—Landscape cleanup, pressure washing outdoor areas, washing windows and technology projects.
- Hillsboro High School (Hilhi) –95 volunteers Painting, assembling new furniture, re-keying lockers, landscape cleanup, trash removal and technology projects.
- Brown Middle School—97 volunteers—Landscape cleanup, painting, trash removal, technology projects and assisting teachers organize and clean classrooms.
- Ladd Acres Elementary School—46 volunteers—Drainage improvements on the playground, landscape cleanup, painting, technology projects and assisting teachers organize and clean classrooms.
- Patterson Elementary School—36 volunteers—Painting, landscape cleanup, technology projects and assisting teachers organize and clean classrooms.
- Rosedale Elementary School—33 volunteers—Landscape cleanup, pressure washing outdoor areas, washing windows and technology projects.
