1. Call to Order and Flag Salute. Board Chair Ortman called the regular session to order at 7:30 p.m. The flag salute was led by Kristen Vandehey, a fifth grade student at North Plains Elementary School. Board Chair Ortman said she needed to leave the meeting and Vice Chair Robb Nerdin would take over the meeting.
2. Recognition. The Board recognized Liberty High School student Yufei Cao for her achievement as a semifinalist in the Intel Science Talent Search. Of the 1,705 students who enter the competition, 300 were chosen for this recognition by Intel. Ms. Cao plans to major in molecular biology in college.

Staff and students from Groner Elementary School gave a presentation to the Board on the American Sign Language Program at the school. The American Sign Language (ASL) program was developed at Groner Elementary School in order to:

- Provide an opportunity for students to learn a second language
- Enrich the culture of their school
- Help improve communication between the hearing students and the students enrolled in the Northwest Regional Education Service District Deaf/Hard of Hearing program that is housed at Groner.

During the first year of implementation, kindergarten students received one hour of instruction a week, and all other classes received from 20-30 minutes a week of instruction. Each year, another grade level (the next higher one) is added to receive the hour of instruction. By 2011, all students at Groner will receive an hour of American Sign Language instruction per week.

- a. Approve Northwest Regional Education District Service District Resolution Plan 2007-08. Superintendent Jeremy Lyon introduced NWRESD Superintendent Jim Mabbott and Chief Financial Officer Tim Collier, who reviewed components of the plan.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING  
NWRESD LOCAL SERVICE PLAN FOR 2007-2008

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Hillsboro School District No.1J, Washington County, Oregon, that for the nature and extent of Core Services, Service Credits and the County Allocation Fund described in the proposed local service plan and in compliance with the provisions of ORS 334.175, the school board of said school district hereby approves the Northwest Regional Education Service District Local Service Plan for the 2007-2008 school year.

Director O'Donnell moved to approve the resolution authorizing the Northwest Regional Education Service District Resolution Plan for 2007-08. Director Rebecca Lantz seconded the motion, which was unanimous.

- b. Approve High School Course Proposals. Executive Director of School Improvement Annie Kelsey and Glencoe teacher Ellen Lyon presented two new elective courses for approval. Director Lantz moved to approve the new high school courses: Engineering Design and Development, and Principals of Engineering. Director Peterson seconded the motion, which was unanimous.
- c. Rename High School Courses. Executive Director of School Improvement Annie Kelsey requested that the Board rename two courses. Liberty High School currently offers courses called Robotics 1 and Robotics 2. Staff request the names of these courses be changed to Engineering Systems (formerly Robotics 1) and Engineering Applications Lab (formerly Robotics 2). The rationale for the name changes is to have course titles that accurately represent course content. Many students believe a course named Robotics focuses on building robots and are disappointed to discover that it does not. Additionally, some students who might otherwise enroll in the course based on the course content will avoid it because they think it does focus on robots. The course content will not change with approval of the name changes. The only impact of the name changes will be the appropriate placement of students in courses they have an interest in. Staffing, budget, and/or impact on other curricular areas will not be impacted by the proposed changes. Director Cordrey moved to approve the proposed high school course name changes. Director O'Donnell seconded the motion, which was unanimous.
- d. Appoint Bond Advisory Panel Members. Executive Director of Communications Nicole Kaufman presented ten names to the Board for appointment to the 2006 Construction Bond Advisory Panel:

Director Peterson moved to appoint the above-mentioned individuals to serve on the 2006 Construction Bond Advisory Panel. Director Lantz seconded the motion, which was unanimous.

- e. Extend Review Period for Policy Sections A and B. Superintendent Jeremy Lyon said that the District has contracted with Oregon School Boards Association to review the District's policy manual. Section A and B, related to the Board's governance of the District, were placed on 30-day review in January. Board input was extensive and a work session to review suggested changes is scheduled for March 6, 2007. Upon completion of that work, the policies will be brought forward for adoption by the Board. Director Lantz moved to extend the review period for

Policy sections A and B to 60 days. Director Peterson seconded the motion, which was unanimous.

7. Reports and Discussion.

a. Teacher Data Teams. Executive Director of School Improvement Dawn Montgomery and teachers Holly Sylvester and Mark Striplin shared information on the data-driven decision-making process being used in Hillsboro. The Data Team process generally occurs during teacher-driven Academic Seminar and includes:

1. Collaborating on curriculum mapping and pacing charts to State Standards and District Power Standards.
2. Developing pre-/post-assessments based on the standards students will master,
3. Administering the common pre-assessment before instruction to determine what lessons students will need.
4. Collaborating on the formal data team process:
  - a. Charting assessment data.
  - b. Analyzing and prioritizing student needs, setting SMART (strategic, measurable, attainable, realistic, timely) goals for their unit of instruction.
  - c. Identifying Instructional strategies/techniques they will use.
  - d. Determining results indicators/evidence that students have learned the skills/knowledge.
5. Teaching and re-teaching as needed.
6. Administering the common post-assessment.
7. Scoring and submitting data to the Data Team leader.
8. Meeting as a team to determine if goals were met and to determine next steps for students who did not master the concepts/skills at a proficient level.

Superintendent Lyon said he is very appreciative of the work teachers are doing and believes they impact the lives of children in a positive way.

b. School Name Task Force. Indian Hills Elementary School Principal Steve Callaway updated the Board on efforts to name four new schools in the District. He said the committee held their initial meetings and has already received name suggestions.

c. 2007-08 School Calendars—30-Day Review. Director of Human Resources Lu Biado presented draft 2007-08 calendars. She said the District will seek input from staff, parents, community members, private schools, and neighboring districts. The calendar was placed on 30-day review.

d. Policy Section C—30-Day Review. Superintendent Lyon presented Policy Section C to be placed on 30-day review.

8. Routine Reports. Routine reports are included in the Board packet in an effort to keep the Board updated on activities in the District.

Hillsboro Classified United Vice President Lila Young thanked the District for helping employees sign up to donate days to a “sick leave” bank. She also expressed concern about the custodial contract with SBM and asked the District to reconsider the contract.

Hillsboro Education Association President Bonnie Kiester said she has been working with Safe Schools/Healthy Students grant staff to organize gang identification workshops and the response has been overwhelming. She also expressed concern about cleanliness of the buildings. In addition, Ms. Kiester noted that the calendar does not provide secondary teachers a half day to get organized and prepared prior to parent conferences in October.

9. Audience Time. There were no comments from audience members.
10. Superintendent's Time. Superintendent Jeremy Lyon said the District does not plan to make up days lost to inclement weather until students miss a fourth day this school year.
11. Board of Education Time. Director McLeod said she loved the enthusiasm and heart of teachers that presented at the meeting this event.

Director Hugh O'Donnell recognized Brown Middle School students and staff for their faithful attendance at Board meetings.

Director Rebecca Lantz said she is very pleased with the "Tag, You're It!" workshops produced by the District as they allow students to come together and find creative outlet for their energies. She attended the Beaverton-Hillsboro Science Fair, and wishes there could be more focus on science in schools. In addition, Director Lantz hopes the District uses predominantly native plants in landscaping so students may become familiar with Oregon plants.

Director Robb Nerdin said he appreciates the opportunity to take his wife and oldest daughter to school district functions such as Liberty High School Arts Night and theatrical productions.

12. Executive Session. No executive session was called.
13. Adjournment. Acting Chair Robb Nerdin adjourned the meeting at 8:55 p.m.
