Hillsboro School District Policy IK Grading Information –

Policy IK provides the framework for our grading system that was adopted in 2010 in order to help students meet the challenges of new graduation requirements for the State of Oregon. The policy is in effect at all Hillsboro secondary schools. The purpose of IK is to provide more clarity into a student’s mastery of educational standards, skills and overall academic achievement. Student’s grades are calculated on a scale of 90% Summative Assessment and 10% Formative Assessments.

Summative Assessments – an assessment given to evaluate and document what students know and are able to do. Teachers decide on the summative assessments and when they are given. These assessments may include but are not limited to: Tests, papers, speeches, projects, portfolios, quizzes, and some homework assignments. It is not the type of assignment that determines whether it is a formative or summative assignment, but the purpose the teacher has in assigning it. If an assignment is meant to determine what a student has learned or can do, then it is a summative assignment.

Formative Assessments – an assessment designed to provide feedback and direction for both teachers and students while students are still learning the material. These assessments may include but are not limited to: quizzes, homework, rough drafts, peer review, class work, etc.
