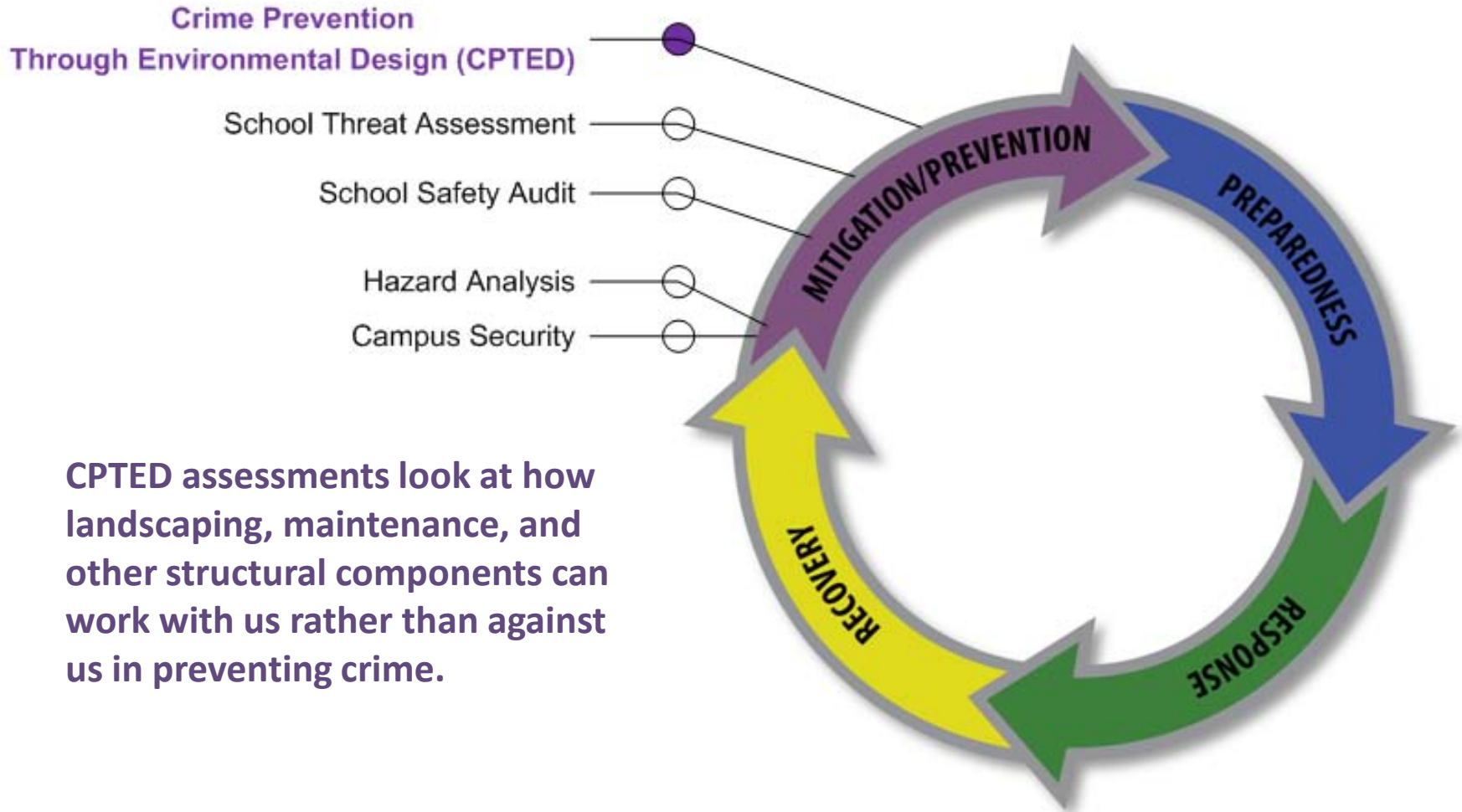
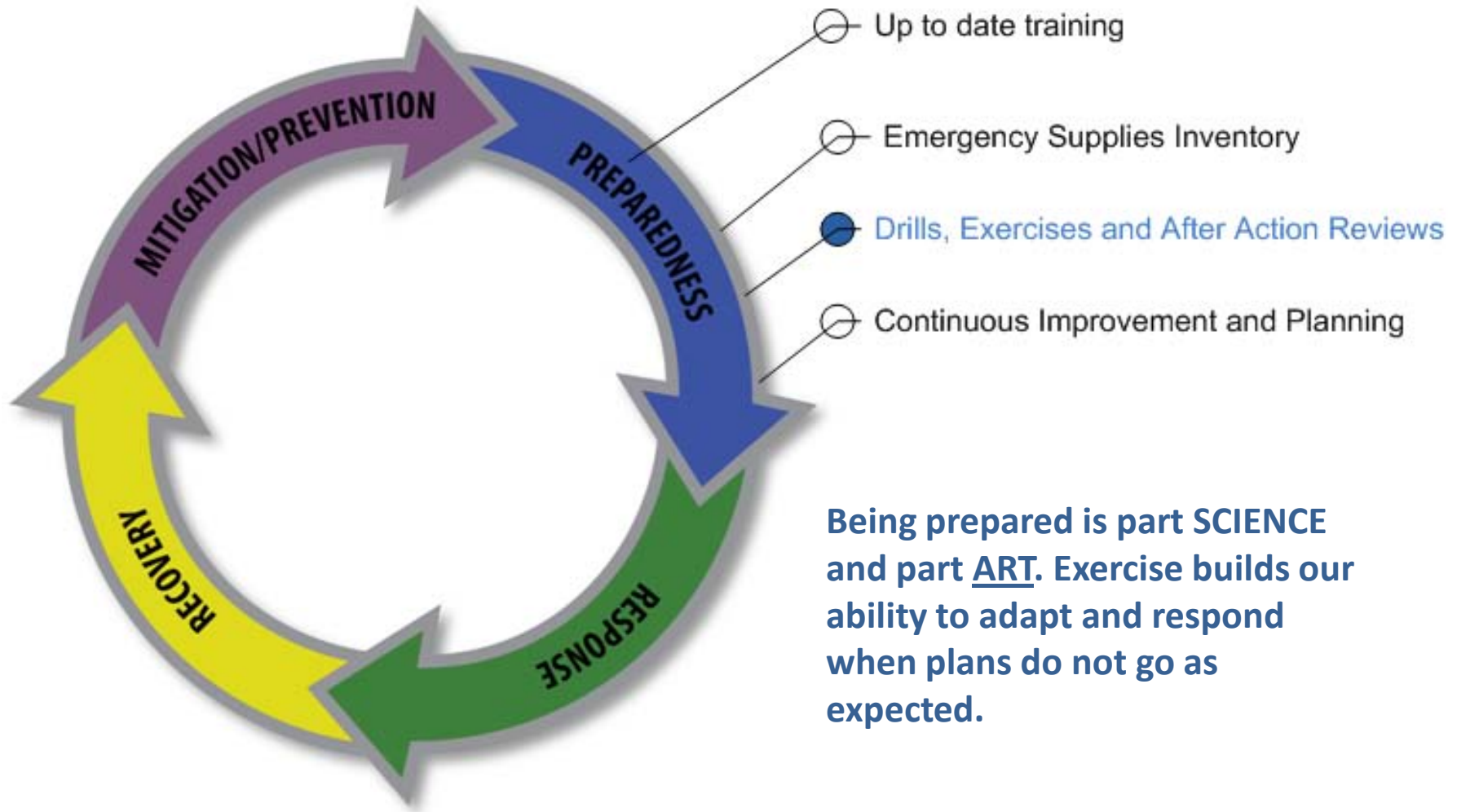

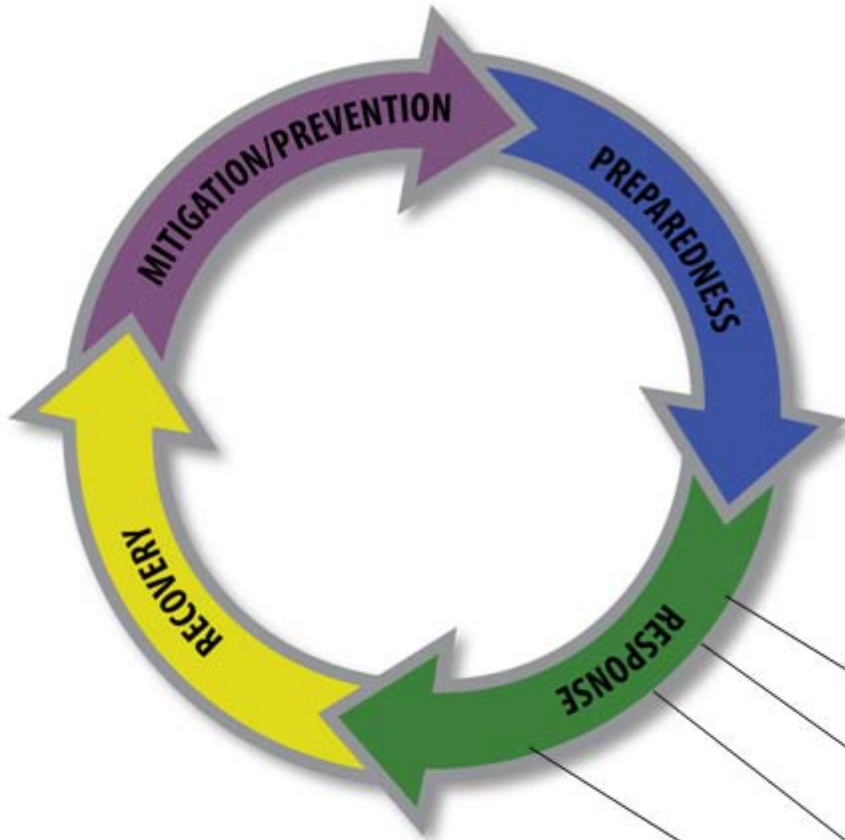


# Preparedness

- School Emergency Response Teams

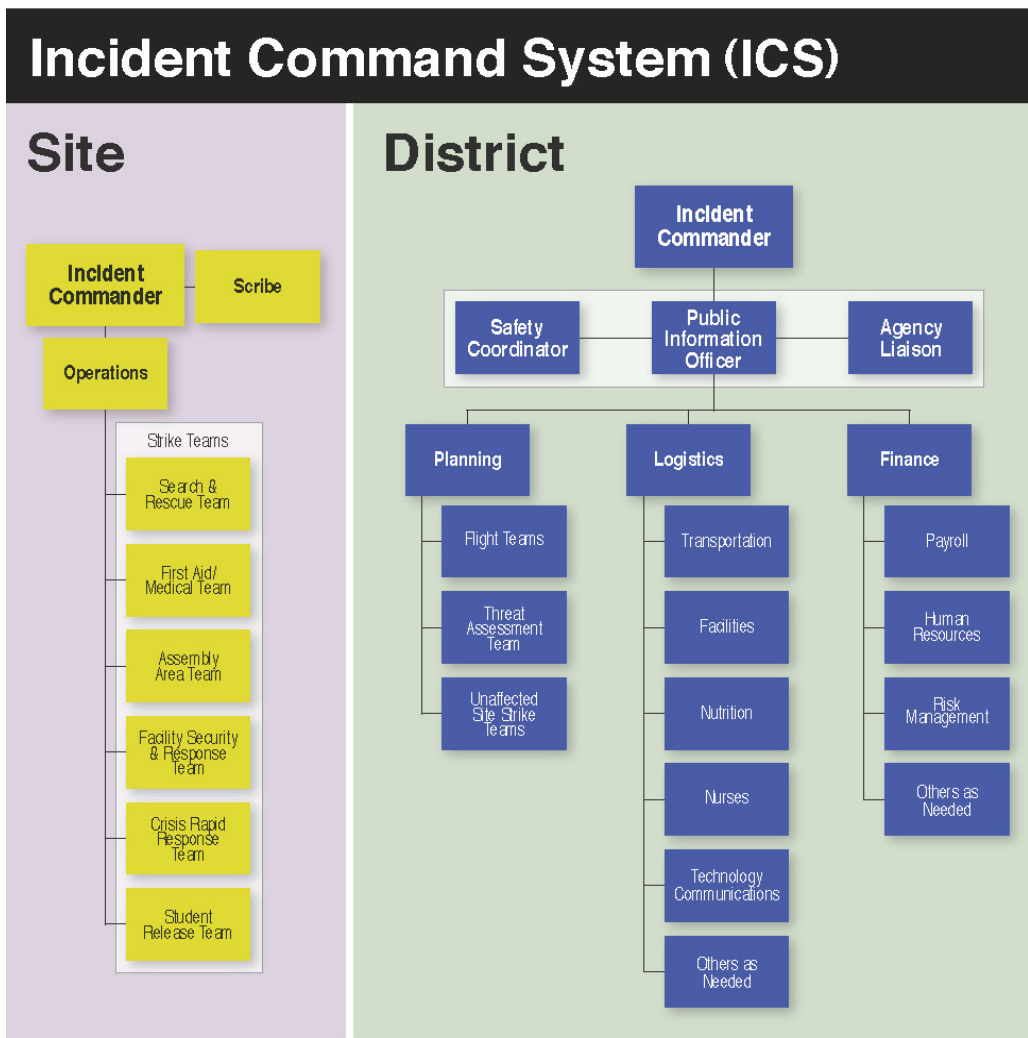
