

# IB Diploma Requirements

## General:

- Complete exams in six subject areas
- Complete TOK
- Complete 150 hours of CAS
- Complete Extended Essay

## Specific:

### *Scores 24-27*

- Obtained a minimum 24 points in six subject areas
- Received grades A (highest) to E (lowest) for both TOK and Extended Essay, with a grade of at least D in one of them.
- Received no grade 1 in any subject
- Received no grade 2 at Higher Level
- Received no more than one grade 2 at Standard Level
- Overall, received no more than three grades 3 or below
- At least 12 points have been gained on Higher Level subjects
- At least 9 points have been gained on Standard Level subjects
- The final award committee has not judged the candidate to be guilty of malpractice.

### *Scores 28-45*

- Received grades A (highest) to E (lowest) for both TOK and Extended Essay, with a grade of at least D in one of them.
- Received no grade 1 in any subject
- Received no more than one grade 2 at Higher Level
- Received no more than two grades 2 at Standard Level
- Overall, received no more than three grades 3 or below
- At least 11 points have been gained on Higher Level subjects
- At least 8 points have been gained on Standard Level subjects
- The final award committee has not judged the candidate to be guilty of malpractice

A maximum of three examination sessions is allowed in which to satisfy the requirements for the award of the IB diploma

A bilingual diploma will be awarded to a successful candidate who:

- Takes two languages A1, or
- Takes a language A1 and a language A2, or
- Takes examinations in at least one of the subjects from group 3 or group 4 in a language other than that offered in group 1.
