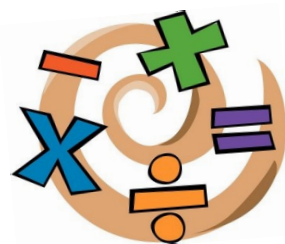
Celebrating over 25 YEARS of Math Excellence At Farmington View!

What is FVPAE?

At Farmington View the Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) concept is branched into two groups: Bobcat Boosters (for general school support); and the Farmington View Parents for Academic Excellence (FVPAE). This is a non-profit organization whose sole purpose is to fund our school's unique accelerated math program, providing a dedicated math specialist on-staff at Farmington View (FV).

In 1996 as FV was incorporated into the Hillsboro School District, the school was faced with the elimination of their advanced math program. Parents, students, and community members came together in support of continuing the program (forming FVPAE) and it has been parent, student, and community-funded for over 20 years now! Additionally, as a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, & Math) school the success of our math program is even more relevant and crucial.

To fund the 2019/2020 school year our mandatory fundraising goal is \$60,000! We need your support as we continue to provide this amazing program for Farmington View students!
