PSA Objectives and Member Activities

AmeriCorps members serve full-time in K-12 schools throughout Washington & Yamhill Counties. While activities vary from school to school, all placements include:

- ★ Tutoring and mentoring for low-achieving and at-risk students in math and/or reading
- ★ Developing, implementing and/or leading before and after school day activities (recreation, academic enrichment, and tutorial activities)
- ★ Volunteer Management including recruiting and coordinating volunteers
- ★ Specialized Projects can include parent engagement, equity work, or other school based initiatives.
- ★ Participating in monthly team-based service projects in Washington County



Member Benefits

- ★ \$1,500 monthly living allowance (subject to income tax)
- ★ \$6,495 Education Award at the conclusion of the service hour requirement. It can be used to pay off existing qualified student loans, or pay tuition for continuing education
- ★ Forbearance from qualified outstanding student loans during service
- ★ Basic health care
- ★ Weekly Trainings & Networking that include graduate credits From Pacific University
- ★ School Based professional development
- ★ Childcare (if eligible)

Intangible benefits include:

- ★ Knowledge that you have made a difference for children and youth
- ★ The satisfaction that comes from serving your community and your country
- ★ The opportunity to work and learn with education professionals on some of the most pressing problems in education today
