Senior Photo Information

Please take this flyer to your photographer

Specifications:

- The photo must be 2" x 3" (or 600 width x 900 height in pixels). Resolution **MUST** be 300 DPI for a high quality photo. Lower DPI may result in a blurry or pixelated photo in the yearbook.
- This photo must be the portrait style (taller than it is wide) -- see the example above
- The photo may be from the shoulders up or a full body shot - **we will not crop it for you**
- We will accept environmental backgrounds
- We will accept any pose that is school appropriate
- We will **NOT** accept photos that have borders or clip art added to them
- We will **NOT** accept photos with watermarks

Submission:

- For best results, submit the photo as a digital JPG or PNG format file
- JPG and PNG files should be titled as such: "last name_first name" (example: Nguyen_Amy), and use the student's FULL LEGAL NAME, not nicknames

Where to Submit Photos:

- Due to COVID 19, submitting your photos will be different this year. Do NOT email photos. This year, our publishing company is creating a free app you can download on your phone that will let you submit your photo there. This will help the yearbook as it will automatically upload them to the yearbook. A video in your advisory class will show you how to use it.

All photos MUST be submitted by February 28th at 3:45 p.m.

If your photo is not received by this time, your school portrait from last year will be used instead. Please follow the above guidelines as faithfully as possible. Any deviation could cause your photo to be lost or printed in poor quality. We appreciate your assistance in keeping this process working.
