¹These schools received a Federal Title I designation of "Focus" in 2011-12. Focus Schools are high poverty schools that were ranked in the bottom 5%-15% of Title I-A schools in the state with a significant achievement gap based on Oregon's rating formula. These schools received additional support to close the achievement gap among historically underserved student populations. Because of the concerted efforts to raise student achievement at these schools, both earned Level 3 status in 2012-13 and 2013-14.

²This school was rated Level 1 for the 2013-14 school year. As such, it will receive \$20,000 from the state for teacher professional development.

³This school received enough points in the rating system to earn a Level 4, but didn't meet the required testing participation level and therefore received a Level 2.
