¹These schools received a Federal Title I designation of "Focus" in 2011-12. Focus Schools are high poverty schools that were ranked in the bottom 5%-15% of Title I-A schools in the state with a significant achievement gap based on Oregon's rating formula. These schools received additional support to close the achievement gap among historically underserved student populations. In the 2015-16 school year, both received a Tier 2 designation, meaning they have demonstrated moderate improvement since identification and are currently receiving adaptive supports and monitoring from ODE.

²CEP stands for Community Eligibility Provision, which is a key provision of The Healthy, Hunger Free Kids Act (HHFKA, Public Law 111-296; December 13, 2010). CEP allows the nation's highest poverty schools and districts to serve meals at no cost to all enrolled students without collecting household applications.
