The Special Educator Added Endorsement (AddSPED) program is designed for elementary or secondary licensed general education teachers who are interested in adding an endorsement in the area of special education. The special education endorsement allows licensed teachers to teach students age 3 through 21 with a range of support needs.

AddSPED graduates are well prepared to work with a wide range of students in a variety of instructional settings. Potential roles include: self-contained special education classroom teachers, learning specialists/resource room classroom teachers, inclusive/co-teaching roles, and transition specialists.

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
