

# Federal Utility Bill Assistance NOW AVAILABLE!



## Have you been impacted by COVID-19 and need help paying your Utility Bill?

Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act funding from the federal government is now available.

City of Hillsboro residential customers impacted by COVID-19 may qualify to receive support for any unpaid balances for water, sewer, and stormwater charges on the City of Hillsboro bill received from March 1 to December 30, 2020.

Apply before funding is no longer available.

### Eligibility

You may be eligible for CARES Act utility assistance if you meet all of the following criteria:

1. You have been impacted by COVID-19 (job loss, reduced work hours, sickness, quarantine, etc.).
2. You have a residential utility account with the City of Hillsboro.
3. You participate in government assistance programs, or your household earns at or below 80% area median income (*see right*).
