OPEN ENROLLMENT DISCUSSION

INTER-DISTRICT STUDENT TRANSFER DISCUSSION

SITUATION

HB2747 requires district school boards to take action and announce any available openings for the acceptance of nonresident students to their districts, and any limitations on the number of students wishing to transfer from their districts. This is the second of the currently available opportunities for students to transfer between districts (the other being open enrollment, as defined by HB3681).

During this meeting, staff will discuss the District's options, and a potential plan for participating in the HB2747 inter-district student transfer process. Board members will be asked to act on the resulting proposal during their April 28, 2015, meeting.

RECOMMENDATION

The Superintendent recommends the Board of Directors discuss inter-district student transfers, and ask any questions they may have.
