**DECLARE PORTABLE CLASSROOM BUILDINGS SURPLUS AND**  
**AUTHORIZE DEMOLITION**

**SITUATION**

School Board Policy DN: Disposal of District Property requires the Board to declare District property as surplus and authorize its disposal when such property is no longer useful to the District, unsuitable for use, too costly to repair, or obsolete.

As part of the 2017 bond program, the District will be replacing obsolete portable classroom buildings at Reedville, W. L. Henry, and McKinney elementary schools with new modular classroom buildings.

At Reedville Elementary School, this includes the following portable classroom buildings:

- Library/Computer Lab Portable – P-15/P-16
- ERC/Wellness Portable – P-13/P-14
- Music Portable – P-1

(Note: P-18/P-19 is a newer portable and will be relocated to North Plains Elementary School)

At McKinney Elementary School, this includes the following portable classroom buildings:

- ESL – P-1
- Preschool – P-2
- Food Pantry – P-3

At W. L. Henry Elementary School, this includes the following portable classroom building:

- Food Pantry – P-1

All of the portable classroom buildings are obsolete, are no longer of value to the District, have no resale value, and will be replaced by new modular buildings.

**RECOMMENDATION**

The Superintendent recommends that the Board of Directors declare the obsolete portable classroom buildings at Reedville, W. L. Henry, and McKinney elementary schools (as identified in this Board meeting packet) as surplus, and authorize their demolition as part of the 2017 bond program.
