



Application for Appointment to the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee

The Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee is established as an advisory committee to the Board of Directors. The Committee shall be composed of 15 at-large community members and up to four (4) high school students. The purpose of the committee is to convene quarterly, or as needed, to review progress on the projects detailed in Hillsboro School District Bond Measure 34-278. The Committee will review program progress and monitor program spending and schedules. The Committee will report quarterly to the Board of Directors regarding program progress.

The Committee will have its initial meeting not later than April 6, 2018, and will be dissolved on January 1, 2022, or upon issuance of a final report by the Committee after all projects authorized by Hillsboro School District Bond Measure 34-278 have been completed, whichever is earlier. Meetings shall be held at a time and location to be determined by the Committee Chair. Applications are due no later than 5:00 p.m. on February 16, 2018.

Eligibility for the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee:

1. Live within the Hillsboro School District
2. Be a registered voter* (*students not req'd to be registered)
3. Not be an officer or employee of the District
