Subject: Head Lice revision per "Head Lice Guidelines"

Provided by Oregon Department of Education and Public Health Division of the Oregon Health Authority

In the event that a student has head lice, Hillsboro School District staff will:

- 1. Students with symptoms of suspected head lice will be referred to school staff for confidential individual screening.
- 2. Staff will follow the "Managing Presumed Head Lice in Schools," algorithm.
- 3. Students with live lice or nits (eggs of head lice), will be allowed to remain in class and participate in school sponsored activities for the remainder of the school day.
- 4. Unnecessary absenteeism leads to missed learning opportunities for the student and potentially lost family wages due to loss of parent/guardian workday.
- 5. Schools will communicate with students' family regarding recognition, prevention, and treatment of head lice. A packet including parent/guardian information sheet on head lice will be sent home with student. Notifying classroom/school families is at the principal's discretion; nurse consult is available.
- 6. The goal is to not exclude a student from school for head lice. Trained staff will perform a confidential head check one week later.
