Commitments

As a Student Board Advisor you are expected to:

- Attend board meetings starting in August of 2018.
- Assist the board in analyzing issues, proposals and requests before it.
- Pick a topic of interest in education policy and present it to the Board of Education.
- Other duties as assigned by the board chair.
