# HILLSBORO SCHOOL DISTRICT Key Points for the 2023-24 School Year

We are so excited to welcome students back to the 2023-24 school year! Please make note of the following important information:

- On Friday, September 1, teachers and other school staff will make connections with students and families and arrange for any needed supports.
- The first day of school for students in grades 1-6, 7 and 9 is Tuesday, September 5; students in grades K, 8, and 10-12 will join them on Wednesday, September 6.
- Your child's school checks out a Chromebook to each student and can assist with internet access resources as needed. <u>Technology assistance</u> is available from 7:30 a.m. through 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, by calling 503-886-8956 or by submitting a request via email to <u>techhelp@hillsboro.incidentiq.com</u>.
- School meals are available for <u>purchase</u>. Families are responsible for meal costs unless their child attends a <u>Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) school</u> or they are approved for free meals. Free meal applications must be submitted each year, even if you qualified in previous school years (apply at <a href="https://lingconnect.com">https://lingconnect.com</a>, or pick up an application at your child's school).
- Bus routing information will be available at <a href="https://www.hsd.k12.or.us/mybus">www.hsd.k12.or.us/mybus</a> as of Tuesday, August 22. Routing information for students entering grades K and 1 will be mailed directly to families.
- Throughout the year, we will be reaching out to families via emails, phone calls, and Remind messages/texts (informational Remind video at <a href="https://youtu.be/W3\_UQAC9hro">https://youtu.be/W3\_UQAC9hro</a>) when there is important information to share, so ensuring that we have your current contact information is extremely important. Please login to your ParentVUE account, open Online Registration, then select the 2023-2024 Verification option to review and update your family information.
- We love to showcase the great things our students are doing, but we also understand that there are situations in which a parent might not want their child's photo taken. Please know that our STANDARD PROCESS IS TO ALLOW PHOTOS. If you are ok with this, no action is necessary. If you want to opt your child out of photos or other "directory information" which includes names, addresses and phone numbers of all 11th and 12th grade students to military recruiters in mid-October, per federal law please fill out a Release of Information Opt Out Form, available from your school's office or on our website at <a href="https://www.hsd.k12.or.us/informationoptout">www.hsd.k12.or.us/informationoptout</a>.
- Oregon Senate Bill 856—also known as Erin's Law—mandates that students receive age-appropriate
  instruction to help them recognize and respond to unsafe situations, and to increase awareness of child
  sexual abuse. Learn more at www.hsd.k12.or.us/erinslaw.
- Oregon law requires several <u>immunizations</u> for school attendance. Proof of these immunizations or completed <u>exception paperwork</u> is required within 30 days of the start of school. Please also fill out a medication administration form for any medication(s) your child needs while at school, and inform the school <u>nurse</u> about any new health conditions or needs.

Union, Witch Hazel, WL Henry, South Meadows, Hilhi, Oak Street Campus) <u>Important:</u> New Expanded Oregon Income Guidelines create more opportunities for families to qualify for free meals. As an example, a family of 4 with a yearly income of \$90,000 or less will qualify for free meals.

Free meals applications need to be submitted each year, even if you qualified in previous school years. Parents are responsible for any meal charges made prior to an application being processed and approved.

Elementary: Breakfast-\$2.00, Lunch-\$3.00;

Secondary: Breakfast- \$2.25, Lunch- \$3.50; Milk-only: \$0.75

#### Stay Connected Using ParentVUE and StudentVUE

ParentVUE is a web portal that allows parents to access real-time information related to their student's education progress. Parents/Guardians can view their student's attendance, grades, assignments, and more. ParentVUE offers a single sign-on to view school information for all enrolled students, regardless of their grade level or school of attendance. ParentVUE is also used at the start of each school year to verify student and parent/guardian contact information.

#### Don't yet have a ParentVUE account?

If you have not yet set up a ParentVUE account, the first step is to obtain a ParentVUE Activation Key from your student's school. Once school is back in session, contact your student's school via phone or email and request an activation key. #### Already have a ParentVUE account but forgot your password?

Sometimes accounts become disabled due to incorrect login attempts or other security reasons. To reactivate your account, call your student's school.

#### Is ParentVUE in multiple languages?

Yes! ParentVUE can be viewed in English or Español. Click on the English or Español link in the lower right corner of the login screen to change language.

#### What is StudentVUE and how does my student access it?

StudentVUE allows students to access their class schedule, assignments, grades, and more. Students access StudentVUE using their school username and password. If your student is new to the district, they will be issued their username and password once school has started.

#### What is Online Registration/Verification and why is it important?

Throughout the year, your student's school and the district will be reaching out to families via emails, phone, and Remind messages/texts when there is important information to share, so ensuring that we have your current contact information is extremely important. Beginning on August 16, you should login to your ParentVUE account, open Online Registration, then select the 2023-24 Verification option to review and update your family information. #### **Alternate Pick-up and Drop-off Information**



Pursuant to Hillsboro School District Policies and Procedures, transportation service may be granted to students to and from an alternative address other than their primary address. This courtesy service may be provided only if, in the sole judgment of the Hillsboro School District, no additional costs will be incurred and the following specific criteria are met:

- The alternative address is within the service area for the student's assigned school or program
- · Service to the alternative address is to be provided on a fixed weekly schedule
- A seat is available on the bus route serving the alternative address
- A bus stop serving the alternative address already exists and is assigned to the bus route
- In addition to these criteria, transportation services may be provided to and from community partnership organization locations that are specifically approved by the District
- It is the parent's responsibility to notify the school when the change has been made.

Please complete this form if your student is to be picked up and/or dropped off at a location other than their home address on a <u>regular established schedule</u>. All requests apply to the current school year only.

Requests for multiple pick-up and drop-off locations that are not on a regular schedule cannot be accommodated. Students may not "choose" where to be picked up or dropped off. Requests for alternate week changes cannot be accommodated. Temporary changes (less than 1 month) must be in the form of a note to the school on the date of the requested change.
