      1. Review total income (before expenses)  
2017: Auc: \$11,000; Bsk \$4500 2016: Auc \$9000; Bsk \$3000 2015: Auc \$7000; Bsk \$2000
      2. This year 2018: about \$12,000 after expenses
        - Baskets: 5304 Tickets = \$2652
        - Games: 2393 Tickets = \$1200
        - Auction: Right at \$10k after expenses
